### Minutes from previous meeting: 1st

1. Sports Uniforms – Nigel and Megan

Letter sent by Nigel re sports uniforms to both PTA and BOT.

Currently we have senior and middle uniforms for basketball which is well catered for, but some items are showing their age.

Currently approximately 100 uniforms for soccer/ hockey comprising of jerseys plus shorts. This covers some needs but not all because of growth and team numbers which means we often have to borrow from rugby clubs. 30 jerseys were bought for middle syndicate but this was never enough to cover our actual need.

110 uniforms for roughly 11 teams entered – sub laminated uniforms would be best – logo shading colours is integrated into the fabric. Megan suggests that Ideally it would be best to see the products to understand fabric properly. Samples can be obtained for comparison.

30 Rugby jerseys – also in school colours will be being quoted for.

At this stage an approximate cost sits around \$10000

Canterbury quote to be obtained from Megan and Gilbert direct from manufacturer.
